Tickets are now on sale for the Susquehanna Folk Festival, an annual two-day music, dance, storytelling, and craft festival held July 28th and 29th. The venue for the event will be Roundtop Mountain Resort, a beautiful Central PA ski destination, located in Lewisberry, Pennsylvania (near Harrisburg and York.) The festival will be held rain or shine, as all of the stages are indoors or under tents. The festival grounds are handicapped accessible.

The Susquehanna Folk Festival is also a perfect destination for vacationers who want stay awhile and explore all that the region has to offer! Performers at the Susquehanna Folk Festival include the legendary David Bromberg, four-time Grammy Award winner David Holt, the great blueswoman Rory Block, amazing Texas swing fiddlers The Quebe Sisters, decorated bluegrass star Claire Lynch, the Celtic power-trio Trian, circus arts with the Give and Take Jugglers the Kulu Mele African Dance & Drum Ensemble, and more!

In addition to music, the festival will feature storytelling performances; contra dancing with Pete's Posse and calls by Kathy Anderson and Janine Smith, swing dance, hip hop and more! A wide selection of crafts will be available for sale, and many artisans and crafters will be demonstrating their art. Food will be available on site and a selection of craft beer and wine from local wineries will be available in the evenings

There will be plenty of activities for children and families too. A fun selection of children's crafts will be available all day and children can join in a jug band, learn to juggle, get a ukulele lesson, or learn to play an African drum. The festival is ticketed for adults, but free for children 12 and under.

Early Bird Two-Day Festival tickets are \$55 General Admission and Single-Day tickets are \$40 for Saturday and \$35 for Sunday. Children 12 and under are free. Prices go up \$5 on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
